### **UCI STAGE RACE**

(Two Road Races, Time Trial, Criterium)

### **ORGANIZATION INFORMATION**

The Walmart Joe Martin Stage Race - is a UCI 2.2 stage race held under USAC permit #2023-7006. The event is owned and promoted by All Sports Productions, Inc., Fayetteville, Arkansas 72701. The UCI rules and scale of penalties are solely applicable.

### **PARTICIPATION**

The number of riders per team is seven with a minimum of five starters. The UCI Pro Men race is open to UCI Pro teams, UCI Continental teams, UCI Cyclo-cross Professional Teams, National Teams, Regional and Club teams. The Women Elite race is open to UCI World Teams (max 3), UCI Women's Continental Teams, UCI Cyclo-cross Professional Teams, National teams\*, Regional and Club teams\*, and Mixed teams\*.

\* Women of the second year of Junior may be included in these teams, provided they have authorisation from the National Federation that issued their license.

Licenses: Riders and Team Managers must have a valid current UCI license. Active participants including officials, drivers, and mechanics, must hold a license from a governing body that is a member of UCI and must show such license on demand.

### **MANAGER'S MEETING - MANDATORY**

The mandatory manager's meeting is Wednesday afternoon, May 17, in the Dining Hall of the Mount Sequoyah Conference Center, 150 Skyline Dr., Fayetteville, AR 72701

All team managers must be present. Vital information will be discussed and materials distributed.

### **CARAVAN DRIVER'S MEETING**

Wednesday 5:45 - 6:45 pm Mount Sequoyah (Dining Hall). This meeting is mandatory for ALL drivers within the race: car driver, motor, medical, support, media, VIP, security, etc. Also beneficial for photographers working from motorcycles. Best practices for working within and around the race are reviewed.

### **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

### Support

Neutral Support will be provided by Shimano Multi-Service by means of two vehicles and one motorcycle for both the UCI Men's and Women's road races. Time Trial will have service at the start and at the mid-way point of the race. Criterium will have 2 pits located after turn 1 and turn 5.

The UCI document is the definitive ruling mandates and that if state laws are more strict those must be followed. Measures are considered "desireable" (DES).

### Summary:

- 1. A health pass, vaccination certificate or negative COVID test will no longer be required before participation in competitions neither for Teams, nor for UCI and ITA personnel, nor for organization personnel.
- 2. Clinical monitoring for all team members (support staff and racers) must be carried out under the responsibility of the team doctors. In the case of suspected or confirmed COVID cases, the above referenced document must be followed.
- 3. Face masks are optional.

### **Medical Services**

University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) will coordinate all medical services throughout the event. Medical Coordinators:

Central EMS, advanced medical personnel and team doctors will follow on pro/elite road races and be staged at the finish lines. Trained personnel will staff the medical tent at each staging area and finish line.

### **Radio Tour**

The frequency for radio tour will be announced at the manager's meetings.

### Littering

Any rider or team intentionally throwing objects outside of the designated Green Zones will be fined per UCI rule 2.12.007.8.3. In addition, local law enforcement will issue citations if someone is observed intentionally littering. Littering is against the law. The race is in danger of not being permitted due to riders/teams' excessive littering.

### **UCI Fines schedule for littering:**

- 1st infringement: CHF 100 fine and 5 points from UCI rankings
- 2nd infringement: CHF 200 fine, 10 points from UCI rankings and a 1 minute penalty
- 3rd infringement: CHF 400 fine, 25 points from UCI rankings and elimination or disqualification

### **Finishes**

After completing your races, please do not congregate at the finish line. Never cross the finish line in the opposite direction or a second time in the same direction. (See UCI 2.12.007.1.6) Be sensitive to the photo finish cameras! Thursday, Friday, and Saturday results will be uploaded to both UCI and USAC websites. UCI team managers will receive a hard copy of results each day. Unofficial results will be sent by email. Results will also be posted on the event website

### In-race Communications

Per UCI 2.2.024, The use of radio links or other remote means of communication by or with the riders, as well as the possession of any equipment that can be used in this manner, during an event is prohibited. Exception: During the time trial.

### **Anti-doping**

Anti-doping inspections may be carried out by the ITA and/or USADA, the USA antidoping and UCI antidoping regulations.



### **Extreme Weather Protocol and the Riders Safety**

A panel, per UCI Chapter 2 Annex B, will consist of PCP, Race Director (or appointee), Race Doctor/Medical rep, Security, Teams' representative (appointed), and Riders' Rep (appointed - not same team as Teams Rep). The representatives will be designated for each concerned event; as per the protocol, a meeting can be convened at the request of any one of the named representatives to the President of the Commissaires' Panel. To this end, both riders' and teams' representatives shall be present during the whole duration of the event in order to be able to attend the meeting in person.

### **SPECIAL REGULATIONS**

### **Road Stages**

Road Closure: UCI Men and Women will have full rolling enclosures at all times, and can use the full width of the road. Whenever the road is more than two lanes wide, riders must use only the right two lanes.

### **TIMING & CLASSIFICATIONS**

### Sign-On and Bib Numbers

Rider sign-on is mandatory at the start line of each stage. Signin will open 70 minutes prior to the start and close 10 minutes before the start for each stage. Exception: Time Trial.

- Racers must successfully complete each stage within the time limit, in order to be eligible to continue to the next stage
- All numbers supplied by the organizer must be used. One frame and two jersey bib numbers will be provided.
- Bib numbers must not be placed in transparent or mesh pockets. Exception: Time Trial.

Both bib numbers will be placed on the left and right side of jersey European style (on jersey pocket with bottom of number facing down). Frame number on bike for all stages except the time trial are required. For time trial, one bib number may be worn on the lower center of uniform.

NOTE: Number, epaulet, cycle plate or frame plate changed (cut, folded) or badly positioned may result in a progressive fines starting at 50 CHF to the rider and the D.S.

### **Summit Finishes**

Friday Road Race is a summit finish for purposes of applying UCI regulation 2.6.027

### **Finishing Time Limits**

- Road Races must finish each road stage within 15% of the winner's time.
- · Time Trial must finish within 30% of the winner's time
- Criterium calculated or actual times must be within 15% of the winner's time

### **Time Bonuses**

Time bonuses will be awarded at intermediate sprints (3", 2", 1") counting towards the Points Classification and at the finish of each stage (10", 6", 4") with the exception of stage 3 time trial for which no time bonuses will be awarded

Individual General Classification (GC)

- Individual rider's general classifications will be calculated by summing that rider's time in all individual stages, taking into account any time bonuses and/or penalties.
- 2. In cases where two or more riders are tied in their final general classifications, their order will be determined by adding the fractions of a second from the individual TT back into the total time. If this does not resolve the tie, the next method is adding their places obtained in each stage. If this does not suffice to break the tie, their placing in the last stage ridden will break ties.

### **Points Classification**

The winner of the points classification must complete the entire race within the time limit. Points will be awarded at intermediate locations and at the finish, except during the Time Trial, where no points are awarded:

- Intermediate Sprints: 5, 3 and 1 points
- Stage Finishes: 15, 12, 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 point

In the event of a tie in the general individual classification by points, the following criteria shall be applied in order until the riders are separated by: Number of stage wins (except the Time Trial), Number of wins in intermediate sprints counting for the classification on points, General Individual Classification by Time.

### **Mountain Classification**

The Mountain Classification concerns each climb selected for this classification. Points are awarded as follows:

- Cat. 1: 5 4 3 1
- Cat. 2: 3 2 1

The mountain classification is established by adding the points awarded on all the climbs counting for the classification. In accordance with article 2.6.017 of the UCI regulations, in the event of a tie, the following criteria shall be applied in order until the riders are separated:

- The number of 1st places in the highest category climbs.
- The number of 1st places on climbs in the next highest category.
- The final individual general classification by time. The winner of the mountain classification must complete the entire race within the time limit.

### **Controls**

Signage will indicate the following distances and locations (except the criterium):

- Distances from the start: 0, 30 kilometers
- Distances to the finish: 25, 20, 10, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 kilometers, 500, 300, 200, 150, 100, 50 meters.
- 1K to Feed, Begin Feed, End Feed
- Begin Green zone, End Green Zone (number as indicated)
- Caravan Detour
- Points Competitions: Green background 1K and 200M to sprint, "Sprint" will mark the line.
- Mountains Competitions: Red background with white 1K and 200M, "KOM/QOM" will mark the line.
- Time Trial Distances will be marked every 1K

### **UCI RACE RULES & INFORMATION**

### **AWARDS PROTOCOLS & LEADERS JERSEYS**

### **Under 23 General Classification (U23)**

The U23 classification is open to riders of racing age 22 or under.

### **Team General Classification**

Team GC calculations will be made by adding the time of the top 3 riders within each team by stage, without figuring into it any individual time bonuses or penalties. In certain cases it is possible to have penalty time applied to the team. Teams with fewer than 3 riders will be eliminated from the team classification. Refer to UCI Regulation 2.6.016 for tie-breaking procedures.

### Leaders' Jerseys - sponsored by PRIMAL

The leader of each classification, except the team classification, shall be required to wear the corresponding distinctive jersey or skin suit. If a rider is leading more than one classification then the next eligible rider will wear the jersey. The order of priority of the distinctive jerseys shall be as follows

- General Classification (GC):
  - Pink (women)
  - Yellow (men)
- Points Classification: Green
- Mountain Classification: Polka Dot
- Under 23 (U23): White GC time

### **AWARDS PROTOCOL**

Stage 3 Time Trial podium will be awarded at the beginning of the Stage 4 Criterium. The following riders are required to present themselves in full team uniform for the daily awards ceremonies:

### Stages 1 - 3:

- The winner of the stage
- · The leader of the General Classification by time
- The leader of the Points Classifications
- The leader of the Mountain Classifications
- The leader of the Under 23 General Classification (U23)

### Stage 4:

- The winner of the stage
- The winner of the Points Classifications
- The winner of the Mountain Classifications
- The winner of the Under 23 General Classification (U23)
- The winners of the Team General Classification (all riders)
- · The first three riders of General Classification by time

### Staging:

Baum Stadium (East Parking Lot) 1420 S. Razorback Rd, Fayetteville, Arkansas 72701 \*\*See Thursday Staging Map for caravan details\*\*

### Course description:

The pelotons will leave Fayetteville on Razorback Road heading south on Hwy 265 to Hogeye.

### Finishing stretch:

The final 11 miles is rolling terrain with a sprint finish which is located on Razorback Rd just north of the 15th Street and Razorback Road intersection. \*\*See Thursday Finish Map for exact caravan deviation details\*\*

### Men Feed Zones:

- 1. Feed Zone #1 Take I-49 south to exit 45, turn right/west onto Hwy. 74. The FZ will be approximately 4 miles from this intersection. GPS Coordinates N 35.780512, W 094.236624
- Feed Zone #2 Take 1-49 south to exit 53, turn right/west onto Hwy 170 and proceed south on Hwy 170 for approximately 9 miles and turn right onto Hwy 265. Feed zone is just after the turn. GPS Coordinates - N 35.835981, W 094.280443. NOTE - Peloton will pass this FZ at 18.8 mi / 30.2 km, but no feeding is allowed.

### Women Feed Zone:

1. Feed Zone - Take I-49 south to exit 45, turn right/west onto Hwy. 74. The FZ will be approximately 4 miles from this intersection. GPS Coordinates - N 35.780512, W 094.236624

**Littering:** There will be three designated Green Zones - one before and one after each feed zone, plus 10K to go to discard bottles. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS PROTOCOL WILL RESULT IN FINES AND SUSPENSION OF PRIVILEGES FROM RACING.

### **Award Ceremonies:**

Podium location is adjacent to finish line. Riders are required to present themselves for the awards ceremonies immediately at the conclusion of the stages. Full team uniform is required.

- The time trial is a stage and will count in team and individual GC.
- Start times will be in reverse order of GC. Start times will be emailed to team managers, posted on the event web site, and the staging area of the time trial at Devil's Den. Starts will be at 30-second intervals based on "time of day". Top 10 will start on 1-minute intervals
- **Neutral support** will be stationed at the halfway point on the course (approximately 2 km). Follow support vehicles are prohibited on the course. Team vehicles are not allowed on the course, but team support personnel are allowed to station themselves on the course provided they do not access the course with a vehicle.
- **Feeding** is not permitted during the time trial.
- Equipment:
  - UCI regulations apply for Stage 3 Time Trial riders must present themselves to bike check 15 minutes before their posted start time.
  - UCI regulations 1.3.023 define three height ranges that determine the morphological exception range that is applicable. Riders not appearing on the UCI List of Tall Riders will automatically be restricted to "Category 1, < 180.0 cm tall". Optionally, these riders may request to be measured after the Team Manager's Meeting following confirmation of riders.
  - Officials will be available for pre-check 1 hour prior to the start of the first rider.

### Course:

- The course is a 3.0 mile / 4.84 kilometer climb out of Devil's Den State Park. The road steadily climbs 725 feet to the finish with an average grade of 5%, with most of the climb at 6% to 8%. Race officials and volunteers will be posted along the Time Trial course.
- CENTER-LINE RULE IS IN EFFECT. Riders must remain to the right of the road at all times. Time penalties may be assessed for flagrant and/or repeated violations. Although the course is closed, race traffic and riders returning to the start will be in the oncoming lane. THERE IS NO WARM-UP ALLOWED ON THE COURSE AFTER 11:30.
- Awards Ceremonies NONE on Saturday. It will take place approximately 1 hour before the start of each group's stage 4 criterium race. The podium is next to rider sign in. Riders must present themselves in full team uniform. Presentation Times are as follows: UCI Women 2:00 pm; UCI Men 3:00 pm; Same protocols apply as Stages 1 & 2.

Directions: The time trial course is approximately 24 miles / 38.7 km (60 minutes driving time) south of Fayetteville.

- Before 11:30 am arrival at the staging area Take I-49 south to exit 45, turn right/west onto Hwy. 74.
- After 11:30 pm arrival at the staging area take I-49 south to exit 53, then proceed south on Hwy 170 to Devil's Den. Address: 11333 West Arkansas Hwy 74, Winslow, AR 72959.

Teams and riders will only be allowed to park in designated areas within the park. Parking across from Campground C area will be the main parking area, which is approximately 1 kilometer from the start. Staging area is located next to the Large Pavilion. The pavilion is close to the dam, swimming pool and restaurant.





**Course:** The course is 1.2 miles / 1.94 km long. A tough climb to the finish will challenge the field as the race progresses. There is NO warming up on the course. The course will be closed from 1:00 pm to 1:30 pm for a kid's ride. Amateur events will be taking place throughout the day.

**Pits:** There are 2 neutral pits on course, located immediately after turns one (just past the Start) & six (after the bottom of the long descent) from start/finish line. Shimano Neutral Race Support staffs both pits. One representative from each Pro Men and Pro Women's team are allowed to provide assistance in each pit. Wheels in, wheels out will also be allowed. Due to limited wheel support area, please remove wheels immediately after your race finishes. The Walmart Joe Martin Stage Race is not responsible for wheels and equipment left in the service areas 30 minutes after a race has ended.

### **Bonuses:**

Intermediate Sprints at the Start/Finish line:

- Men sprint laps at 22, 18 and 10 to go. The bell will be rung at 23, 19 and 11 to go
- Women sprint laps at 12 and 8 to go. The bell will be rung at 13 and 9 to go.
- Race announcer will alert riders with the bell for the upcoming sprint lap.

Intermediate KOM/QOM Points at the Start/Finish line (Cat 2):

- Men lap 14 to go. The bell will be rung at lap 15 to go
- Women lap 10 to go. The bell will be rung at lap 11 to go.
- · Race announcer will alert riders with the bell for the upcoming mountain point lap.

**Mishaps:** Free lap rule is in effect for recognized mishaps. Riders will not be permitted to reenter the race when the lap cards display 4 or fewer laps remaining. They will be given the time of the group they were with as determined by the panel of commissaries and will be placed behind riders completing the last lap of the race.

**Time Limit:** All riders about to be lapped will be pulled from the race at the finish line by the officials and assigned a calculated time based on their average speed at the time they were pulled. Riders' calculated or actual finishing times must be within 15% of the winner's time.

### **Pro Team Criterium Parking Information:**

Pro Men and Women teams with team-only vehicles are required to park in a team-designated area near the start/finish and within the course perimeter. This area can be accessed from College Ave. on Meadow St.

**AWARD CEREMONIES:** ALL CLASSIFICATIONS immediately after the stage finish. The podium is located at the Vendor Expo next to Pro Team parking area. Team uniforms required for all presentations.


